



How to Buy Original Art at Union Street Gallery

Union Street Gallery is pleased to act as a conduit between artist and collector. Our gracious walls are designed to help you see each individual artwork in its best light. When inquiring about a specific piece, we invite you to speak with any of our Gallery Staff, Volunteers, or Union Street Gallery Board Members. Look for our name badges sporting the Gallery Logo.

Because Union Street Gallery is a post 9-11 non-profit gallery, all purchases are made directly to the artist who created the work. Gallery staff assists with this, handling your payments, including sales tax, and then presenting those funds to the artist. Artists, in turn, graciously donate a portion of the sale price back to Union Street Gallery to help manage this beautiful facility.

Methods of payment include cash, checks, or installment payments.

Many artists offer installment payments using a payment schedule comfortable for both artist and buyer.

When may you take possession of your wonderful new artwork?

All Gallery exhibitions (except "12th Month" holiday show) request that sold pieces remain on view for the duration of the exhibition. Buyers are welcome to pick up their artwork at the end of the show. Artworks sold during exhibition are noted with a red dot on the tag. (It is rather exciting to see *your* red dot!)

Will you meet the creator of your artwork?

Yes! in most cases, artists are present for opening receptions and other Gallery events. Gallery staff are pleased to make introductions! Some of our artwork is shipped to Union Street from other parts of the US. If your artwork was created by an artist unable to attend Gallery activities, Union Street has complete biographical information about your artist, along with an "Artist's Statement" often prepared *specifically* for your artwork. Most artists are thrilled to hear from their patrons and relish the opportunity to meet in person.
